We hope to provide an atmosphere for enjoyable physical exercise and positive instruction in the basic fundamentals of teamwork and good sportsmanship.



Our facilities include a two court gymnasium located at 117 Milton Road adjacent to Eno Valley Elementary School and a multi-purpose complex in Old Farm off Rippling Stream Rd. adjacent to the city park. HAA provides basic equipment for all of our teams. All equipment provided is expected to be returned at the end of each season.

We continue to need volunteers in many areas. We need people on our board who are concerned about the future of this association. We need people to coach teams who are concerned about our children. We need people to help maintain the quality of our playing facilities. Help keep our facilities clean; use

HAA offers a full schedule of year-round programs which include:

**BASEBALL/SOFTBALL: SPRING**

Boys 5-15 and Girls 5-13.

**SPRING SOCCER:**

Boys and Girls 5-17

**CO-REC SOFTBALL: JULY**

Adults, boys and girls 13 or older.

**SOCCER: FALL - Boys and Girls 5-17**

**MICRO-SOCCER: Boys & girls age 4**

**BASKETBALL: WINTER**

Boys & Girls age 5-18 (High School)

**SPORTS FEE:** \$75 for the 1st child and \$55 for each additional child for each sport. You will keep your child's shirt upon the completion of the sport season. Fees subject to change.

**LATE SIGN UPS:** There is a \$10 fee in addition to the sport fee. (Effective after sport draft)

#### CONDUCT - SPORTSMANSHIP

This is a rec league. Remember that the games are for the kids. The officials in each sport are empowered to eject any player, coach, or fan if they (the player, coach, or fan) engage in unsportsmanlike conduct. Examples of unsportsmanlike conduct are: heckling players; fighting; threatening a player, coach, fan, or official; excessive arguing with an official; entering the court/field while the game is in progress without the permission of the official; cursing, vulgarities, and abusive language; or any other conduct that the official deems unsportsmanlike; whether you agree or not. Weapons of any type, alcohol, and pets are not permitted in our facilities. Offenders may be banned from the Association. Officials include the game

officials and representatives of Holt Athletic Association.

It is understood and accepted that as part of my membership (membership includes the entire family) in Holt Athletic Association that I/We agree to the rules and policies of Holt Athletic Association.

The ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP meeting is held in March of each year and is open to all members. The members of Holt Athletic Association elect the Board of Directors and its officers at this meeting. This is your opportunity to voice your opinion and provide recommendations.
